COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

1. DESCRIPTION

- Opportunity for college-ready students, grades 7-12, who qualify for college admission to take college classes and receive college and high school credit. CC+ replaces PSEO and Dual Enrollment

2. COST

- There is no cost (tuition, books, fees, etc.) to students for participating in CC+ at an Ohio Public University. (If you choose to attend a private institution, you may have to pay a fee.)
- Students will pay for classes that they fail.

3. COUNSELING

- Students must attend an informational meeting about CC+ with the high school counselor. Partnered colleges will be in attendance.
- If you choose to do CC+, you must attend a counseling session with an advisor at the college.

4. OPTIONS

- Students may earn high school credits through any combination of college classes and classes taken at the high school.
- Students may attend multiple colleges in one school year.
- Students may follow the listed pathways with the partnered institution; however, this is not required.

- Students may take college classes at the university, on line, or at the high school (when available).

5. DEADLINES

- If you choose to participate in CC+, you must sign a letter of intent and turn it in to your counselor by April 1.
- Students must apply to the college by the specified admission deadline as required by the college you are attending.

6. REQUIREMENTS

- These are determined by the college
