~**Edison State Community College** is offering ACT Exam Prep for only \$79. It is held every Tuesday and Thursday either 4:30-6:30 or 6:30-8:30 in the evening from September 24-October 14. See the Guidance Office bulletin board for more information.

~If you are in a **Dual Enrollment** class and want college credit for the class, keep in mind that there may be enrollment requirements like ACT scores, tests, as well as applications. Be sure that you pay the fee for the class too.
